STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN TO BE DEVELOPED FOR SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY RAIL CORRIDOR *Public Meetings Planned for November 8, 2006*

(Stockton, CA)—Members of the public are invited to a public workshop on Wednesday, November 8, 2006, to provide input on a Strategic Business Plan being developed for the San Joaquin Valley Rail Corridor. The meeting will be held from 5:00pm to 7:00pm at the State Building Hearing Room, 2550 Mariposa Mall, Room 1036, Fresno. Refreshments will be served, and maps and other exhibits will be available for public review. Brief presentations will be made at 5:00pm and 6:00pm.

The November 8 public workshop for a Strategic Business Plan is sponsored by the San Joaquin Valley Rail Committee and California Department of Transportation Division of Rail. When completed, the plan will chart the course for future development of the corridor, based on input during the public outreach process.

Also, on November 8, beginning at 1:30pm, a presentation on the Strategic Business Plan will be made at the Council of Fresno County Governments, 2035 Tulare Street, Suite 201, Sequoia Room. This meeting is also open to members of the public.

According to the California Department of Finance, the Central Valley's population will grow from 3.5 million to 9.0 million by 2046. This growth will have a profound effect on mobility.

The goals for the corridor could include improved on-time performance, additional train service, improved safety and reliability, better schedules and more destinations. Other issues of local importance could include more destinations throughout the Central Valley, including a potential line along the Union Pacific Railroad corridor from Bakersfield to Merced; and shorter travel times to the Bay Area, Sacramento, and Los Angeles.
